AN ACT AUTHORIZING SALARIES OF POLICE COMMANDERS — METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections forty-five and forty-
2 six of chapter thirty each officer holding the rank of Captain or
3 above in the metropolitan district police shall receive a base salary
4 nine percent greater than the regular salary payable to the next
5 subordinate grade in accordance with a schedule submitted by the
6 secretary of administration to the house and senate committees
7 on ways and means. The secretary of administration and finance
8 in consultation with the commissioner of the metropolitan district
9 commission shall establish procedures for a review of said salary
10 schedule and submit recommendations for adjustments in
11 subsequent years in the house and senate committees on ways and
12 means.
