AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING LOTTERY FUND DISTRIBUTIONS TO CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws
2 as they appear in the 1986 Official Edition is hereby amended by
3 adding at the end of line 17 the following phrase: — “provided
4 that no distributions to cities and towns shall be earmarked.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 18C of Chapter 58 of the General Laws,
2 as it appears in the 1986 Official Edition is hereby amended by
3 adding after line 54 the following new paragraph: — “Lottery fund
4 revenues distributed to cities and towns through the provisions
5 of this Section shall not be earmarked in any way.
