Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 4 Section . Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
- 5 department of elder affairs, and the Councils on Aging, shall
- 6 provide home care services to all persons over seventy years of
- 7 age, who are sick and invalided, upon request.
