

By Mr. Walsh of Agawam, petition of Michael P. Walsh relative to further regulating certain health care plan restrictions. Insurance.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PLAN RESTRICTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 110K of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as added by
2 section 1 of chapter 615 of the Acts of 1985, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof
4 the following:

5 Each employer or other organization which employs or has
6 twenty-five or more employees or members during the full
7 preceding calendar year and which contributes to a health
8 insurance contract providing comprehensive dental benefits,
9 which restricts the covered persons in selecting the providers of
10 dental services to a single provider or limited number of providers
11 shall also offer its employees and their eligible dependents and
12 members and members' eligible dependents at the time such a
13 dental benefits plan is offered or renewed, the option of selecting
14 alternative coverage which permits covered persons to obtain
15 dental services from any licensed dentist.
