AN ACT AUTHORIZING RICHARD B. CURRY TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR STATE POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for
3 appointment as a state police officer, Richard B. Curry shall be
4 eligible for appointment to the position of state police officer and,
5 provided he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for cer-
6 tification and appointment.
