AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING OFFICERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following sentence: — “For the purpose of this
- 3 section, probation officers and court officers shall be considered
- 4 officers of the Commonwealth.”
