AN ACT REDUCING THE TAX RATE ON CERTAIN UNEARNED INCOME OF PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out subsection (a), as most recently amended by section
- 3 41 of chapter 684 of the acts of 1975, and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following subsection: -
- 5 (a) Part A taxable income shall be taxed at the rate of ten per
- 6 cent; provided, however, that the first fifteen thousand dollars of
- 7 such income of a person who is sixty-five years of age or older
- 8 during the taxable year shall be taxed at the rate of five per cent.
