

HOUSE No. 3798

By Mrs. Kehoe of Dedham, petition of Marie-Louise Kehoe relative to certain ways or boulevards under the control of the Metropolitan District Commission. Housing and Urban Development.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN WAYS OR BOULEVARDS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 37 of chapter 92
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition,
3 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — No such
4 rule or regulation shall prohibit the use of trucks on ways,
5 parkways or boulevards without at least thirty days prior notice
6 to any city or town affected by such rule or regulation and a public
7 hearing thereon.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the metropolitan district commission
3 shall hold a public hearing to reconsider any prohibition on the
4 use of trucks issued on or after May first, nineteen hundred and
5 eighty-six on ways, parkways or boulevards under their control
6 pursuant to chapter ninety-two of the General Laws. Any city or
7 town affected by such prohibition shall be given at least thirty days
8 notice of said hearing.
