AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCREASING TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN PERSONS
AGE SIXTY-FIVE OR OVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 456 of the Acts of 1970,
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4, 6, and 7, the word
4 "seventy" and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the
5 word: — sixty-five.
