AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT ALLOWED FOR GROSS RECEIPTS OF INDIVIDUALS SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE AND OVER TO QUALIFY FOR PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by deleting, "thirteen
- 3 thousand" in lines 962-963 and inserting "twenty-three thousand"
- 4 in its place. Also, by deleting, "fifteen thousand" in line 964 and
- 5 inserting "twenty-five thousand" in its place.
