AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE CONTRIBUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 55 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 7 the following section: —

3 Section 7A. No political committee organized or operating on
4 behalf of a candidate for public office shall contribute more than
5 one hundred dollars per year to any political action committee
6 or political party, nor shall the aggregate total of such
7 contributions from such political committee exceed fifteen
8 hundred dollars per year.

9 Violation of any provision of this section shall be punished by
10 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more
11 than one thousand dollars, or both.
