RESOLVE DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF THE COMMONWEALTH ASSISTING THE TOWN OF NEWBURY AND THE CITY OF NEWBURYPORT WITH FINANCIAL AID IN THE MAINTENANCE OF THE PUBLIC BEACHES AT PLUM ISLAND.

1 *Resolved*, That the Department of Environmental Manage-
2 ment is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation
3 and study to determine the feasibility of the Commonwealth
4 assisting the Town of Newbury and the City of Newburyport with
5 financial aid in the maintenance of the public beaches at Plum
6 Island.

7 Said Department shall, in the course of its investigation,
8 examine the use of the beaches by non-resident population, the
9 violation of beach rules and regulations, the cost to said Town
10 and said City of lifeguard salaries, equipment, litter removal, and
11 other such matters as the Department deems necessary.

12 Said Authority shall report to the General Court the results of
13 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
14 together with the drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
15 recommendations into effect by filing same with the clerk of the
16 Senate on or before the first Wednesday in November, 1988.
