AN ACT REGARDING THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN PERSONS FOR APPOINTMENT AS POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph eight of section  
2 twenty-six of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws or of any other  
3 general or special law to the contrary, the son or daughter of John  
4 J. Foley of Braintree who passes the required written and physical  
5 examination for entrance to the police service shall have his or  
6 her name placed on the eligible list for appointment to such service  
7 immediately below the names of disabled veterans as provided for  
8 in the first paragraph of said section twenty-six of said chapter  
9 thirty-one.
