

AN ACT RELATING TO THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS BY HOUSING AUTHORITIES. Chap.105

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 372 of the acts of 1946, as most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 479 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — In carrying out the provisions of this act, any city or town in which a housing authority has been organized under chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the General Laws shall use such housing authority as its agent, and all moneys appropriated under this act or received by such city or town for the purposes of this act from any source shall, except as provided in section eight B of this act, be paid to the treasurer of the authority or such other officer of the authority as may be authorized by it, and shall be disbursed by such treasurer or other officer subject to section twenty-six U of said chapter one hundred and twenty-one.

SECTION 2. Section 26Q of chapter 121 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 574 of the acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — All moneys appropriated under this section in aid of a housing authority or received by it from any source shall be paid to the treasurer of the authority or such other officer of the authority as may be authorized by it, and shall be disbursed by such treasurer or other officer, subject to section twenty-six U. *Approved February 20, 1950.*

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE TO SELL A PORTION OF PLAINVILLE PARK TO THE JOHN EDWARD McNEIL POST AMERICAN LEGION BUILDING ASSOCIATION. Chap.106

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The town of Plainville is hereby authorized to sell a portion of Plainville park, so called, for a sum not less than one hundred dollars to the John Edward McNeil Post American Legion Building Association as the site for a building to be constructed by said association.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TRAPPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS. Chap.107

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 68 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 758 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further amended by striking out clause (b) and inserting in place thereof the following: —

(b) To trap between March second and six o'clock ante meridian on the following November fifteenth, both dates inclusive.
