3 and study of House document numbered 3627 relative to

7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk  
9 of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday  
10 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
