

ACTS, 1980. - Chap. 544.

hereby further amended by striking out sections 1 and 2 and inserting in place thereof the following two sections:-

Section 1. The county commissioners of Hampshire county are hereby authorized to construct and originally equip a jail and house of correction which shall be constructed at a location acquired for such purpose. Said commissioners may expend for the purpose of this act, including the preparation of plans and specifications in connection therewith and for landscaping, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, eight million eight hundred and fifty thousand dollars. Any sums received from the federal government or the commonwealth for the purposes of this act shall be included in, and considered a part of, the total amount authorized to be expended hereunder.

Section 2. For the purpose set forth in section one, the treasurer of said county with the approval of the county commissioners may borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be necessary not exceeding in the aggregate, eight million eight hundred and fifty thousand dollars and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Hampshire County Jail and House of Correction Loan, Act of 1977. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not more than thirty years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their face value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 544. AN ACT EXEMPTING NONCOMMERCIAL VEHICLES FROM THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR USERS OF SPECIAL FUELS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith exempt noncommercial vehicles from the licensing requirements for users of special fuels, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

ACTS, 1980. - Chaps. 545, 546.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The fourth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 64E of the General Laws, as appearing in section 64 of chapter 415 of the acts of 1976, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to noncommercial passenger vehicles having a fuel tank capacity of not more than twenty-five gallons, self-propelled campers or auto homes used exclusively for noncommercial purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall be effective for the taxable year commencing January first, nineteen hundred and eighty.

Chap. 545. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DESCRIPTION OF CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF LANCASTER TO BE CONVEYED BY THE COMMONWEALTH TO ROBERT G. HARRINGTON.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for the proper description of certain land to be conveyed by the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 768 of the acts of 1979 is hereby amended by striking out, in the description, the words "BEGINNING at a point which is Sixty-Five (65) feet North 05° 40' 18" East and 33.13 feet S. 64° 29' 20" W. from a bounded mark H." and inserting in place thereof the words:- BEGINNING at a point which is Sixty-Five (65) feet North 05° 40' 18" East and 33.13 feet S. 64° 29' 20" E. from a bounded mark H.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of November fifteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
