**AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING VOLUNTARY PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS
FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Offi-
2 cial Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 14 the
3 following section: —

4 Section 14A. Nothing contained in this chapter shall be
5 deemed to prohibit a public employee from distributing or collect-
6 ing payroll deduction cards for the purpose of a public employee
7 organization political education fund fee administered by such
8 employee organization.
