AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF COHASSET TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN REVOLVING FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter
2 forty-four of the General Laws, the town of Cohasset is hereby
3 authorized to establish three separate funds which shall be kept
4 separate and apart from all other funds of said town by the
5 treasurer/collector and in which shall be deposited all monies
6 received by the planning board, board of health and conservation
7 commission of said town from persons seeking permits and
8 approvals from said agencies.

9 Such funds and interest thereon shall be expended without
10 further appropriation by said agencies for engineering, legal and
11 other costs incurred by said agencies in reviewing plans
12 applications and other documents relating to the matter for which
13 a permit or approval is sought. Each agency shall, by regulation,
14 establish the amount of the deposit to be paid by persons seeking
15 such permits or approvals. Upon final disposition of each matter
16 any monies remaining unspent shall be returned to the person who
17 paid same.

18 The town treasurer/collector shall maintain separate records of
19 deposits and disbursements for each fund.
