AN ACT RELATIVE TO INTEREST ON PROCEEDS PAYABLE UPON THE DEATH  
OF THE INSURED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 119C of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out,
- 3 in lines 4 and 5, the words "receipt by the insurer of proof of the
- 4 insured's death" and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 5 "the death of the insured and upon receipt by the insurer of proof
- 6 of the insureds death".
