1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Judiciary be authorized to sit
2 during the current session and recess of the General Court for the
3 purposes of making an investigation and study of current House
4 document numbered 3282, relative to the lands records
5 commission.

6 Said committee may, in the course of its duties, travel within
7 the commonwealth and shall report its findings and its
8 recommendations, if any, to the Clerk of the House of
9 Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in December,
10 nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
