AN ACT RELATIVE TO POSTING NOTICES OF EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of Section 18 of the General Laws Chapter
2 31 is hereby deleted and the following inserted:

3 The administrator shall prepare notices of all examinations for
4 original appointment to the official service and shall send such
5 notices to the clerks of those cities and towns where persons are
6 domiciled who may be eligible to apply to take such examinations.
7 The clerks shall cause a minimum of five such notices to be posted
8 in the city and town halls and in other conspicuous places for
9 at least three weeks prior to the final day for the filing of applica-
10 tions for the examination or, if no such final day for filing is
11 indicated, as directed by the administrator. The clerks of such
12 cities and towns shall submit an annual report to the administra-
13 tor certifying that all such notices have been posted pursuant to
14 the requirements of this section. The administrator shall deter-
15 mine when such annual report shall be submitted and the specific
16 information it shall contain concerning the time and place of post-
17 ing of notices.
