**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES IN THE LAWS AFFECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section ten of Chapter one hundred eleven of the  
2 General Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section fourteen of said Chapter is hereby  
2 repealed.

1 SECTION 3. Section fourteen A of said Chapter is hereby  
2 repealed.

1 SECTION 4. Section 46 of said Chapter is hereby amended by  
2 striking out Section 20 and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
3 ing new section: —

4 Section 20. Records of birth and death previously held by the  
5 superintendent of Tewksbury Hospital shall be transferred to the  
6 town clerk of Tewksbury. No certified copies of these records shall  
7 be issued by the superintendent of Tewksbury Hospital.

1 SECTION 5. Said Chapter is further amended by inserting  
2 after Section 69K: —

3 Section 69L. The commissioner shall establish rules for the  
4 control, movement and parking of vehicles on the lands within  
5 the charge of the department or the various institutions under its  
6 jurisdiction, and shall provide reasonable penalties for the viola-  
7 tion of said rules. The commissioner may authorize the towing  
8 of vehicles parked in violation of said rules, and the owner of a

9 vehicle which is towed shall be liable, in addition to the penalty  
10 for such violation, for the charge for removal and storage of the  
11 vehicle. Citations for violation of any rule established pursuant  
12 to this section may be issued by special police officers appointed  
13 pursuant to section 10C of chapter one hundred and forty-seven,  
14 local and county law enforcement personnel and the state police.

1 SECTION 6. Section 37 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and insert-  
3 ing in place thereof the words: — on a form prescribed by the  
4 Department of Public Health.
