AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE RECREATIONAL TRAMWAY BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 71H of Chapter 143 of the General Laws, as added by
2 Chapter 565, Acts of 1968, is hereby amended by striking the first
3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:
4 There shall be in the department, but not under the control of
5 the commissioner, a recreational tramway board, in this section
6 and sections seventy-one I to seventy-one O, inclusive, called the
7 board, consisting of the commissioner or a member of the depart-
8 ment designated by him from time to time, and six persons
9 appointed by the governor for terms of four years, of whom one
10 shall be a person who owns or operates a rope tow, one a person
11 who owns or operates a recreational tramway other than a rope
12 tow, one a representative of ski clubs or other organizations of
13 persons who patronize recreational tramways, one a person who
14 owns or operates a recreational aerial tramway, one a representa-
15 tive of the wire rope industry and one a representative of com-
16 panies writing liability insurance on recreational tramways. The
17 governor shall from time to time designate one of the appointive
18 members to serve as chairman.
