AN ACT REQUIRING TRUCKS TRANSPORTING SCRAP CARS TO HAVE SIDE PANELS AND BACK PANELS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 19E the following section: —
- 3 Section 19F. Any truck engaged in the transportation of
- 4 scrapped motor vehicles shall be equipped with side panels and
- 5 back panels.
