AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSURANCE RATES FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7A of Chapter 32B of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by the deletion of the last sentence of the first paragraph
- 3 and the insertion in place thereof of the following sentences:
- 4 No governmental unit, however, shall provide different
- 5 subsidiary or additional rates or benefits to any group or class
- 6 within that unit except as such unit may agree to provide to police
- 7 chiefs, fire chiefs, town managers, mayors and school
- 8 superintendents.
