AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES TO CHANGE THEIR RETIREMENT OPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Option (c) of subdivision (2) of section 12 of chapter 32 of the
- 2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 If a spouse who has been designated as a beneficiary dies after
- 5 the effective date of the retirement allowance but before the death
- 6 of the retired member, and there are no surviving children under
- 7 age eighteen, such member, upon his written request on a pre-
- 8 scribed form filed with the board, may make a new election of
