AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETURNING A PORTION OF THE SALES TAX REVENUE TO THE CITY OR TOWN FROM WHICH IT WAS GENERATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby

4 tax shall be paid by the vendor to the commissioner at the time
5 provided for filing the return required by section sixteen of chap-

7 return 20% of said excise tax to the city or town in which it was
