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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF WOMPATUCK STATE PARK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of sections 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17  
2 of chapter 58 of the General Laws are hereby made applicable  
3 to Wompatuck state park, situated in the towns of Hingham,  
4 Norwell and Cohasset, which at the time of its acquisition was  
5 under the care and control of the federal government.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section 15A of said chapter 58  
2 shall not be applicable to said Wompatuck state park.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

**SECTION 1.**

That the Secretary of the Interior be and he is hereby authorized to

do all such things as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.
