AN ACT PROVIDING FREE PARKING FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS AT THE WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET FACILITIES OF THE STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steam-
- 2 ship Authority is hereby authorized and directed to establish at
- 3 its Hyannis and Woods Hole facilities areas for the parking of
- 4 automobiles, without fee or charge, with registration plates
- 5 bearing an insignia designation indicating that a handicapped per-
- 6 son is the operator or occupant of such automobile.
