AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LEAVE WITHOUT LOSS OF PAY FOR CERTAIN INCAPACITATED COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Section 111F is hereby amended by  
2 adding to the first paragraph thereof the following new  
3 sentence: —

4 “This section shall also apply to any employee of a county whose  
5 regular or incidental duties require the care, supervision or  
6 custody of prisoners, criminally insane persons or defective  
7 delinquents.”

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
