AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTIFICATION OF CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT AS FIRE FIGHTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding so much of the provisions of section twenty-
2 six of chapter thirty-one or of any other general or special law
3 or rule to the contrary as relates to the order of certification of
4 names of candidates for appointment from an eligible list, upon
5 the request of the appointing authority, the name of any employee
6 of the fire alarm division of a fire department in a city or town
7 employed as a fire alarm operator who passes the examination
8 for original appointment to the position of firefighter shall be
9 certified for appointment in said city or town after the name of
10 any qualified spouse or single parent of a veteran who was killed
11 in action or died from a service connected disability incurred in
12 wartime service and before the names of all other qualified
13 candidates, according to the score such employee received on the
14 most recent examination therefor.
