AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A LIMITED MILITARY RETIREE EXEMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, is hereby amended
- 2 by adding after paragraph (b), the following paragraph: —
- 3 (c) notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the first
- 4 three thousand dollars of retirement pay for all retired members
- 5 of the armed forces of the United States, who have attained the
- 6 age of sixty-five prior to the beginning of the taxable year, shall
- 7 be exempt from taxation.
