AN ACT REGULATING THE TEACHING OF SEX EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The teaching of sex education shall not be allowed in all
2 Massachusetts public schools, grades kindergarten through grade
3 twelve, or any vocational school or trade school, or any other
4 public school to grade twelve, unless voted by a majority vote on
5 a question on a town or city election ballot, a petition of six-
6 hundred names of registered voters, or five percent of the
7 registered voters be required to place the question on the ballot
8 as follows:

9 Question: Shall the town or city allow the teaching of sex
10 education in the public schools, grades kindergarten through
11 grade twelve. Vote Yes or No.
