AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEPTAGE DISPOSAL IN CERTAIN EMERGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 31D of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the second paragraph the follow-
- 3 ing: —
- 4 Upon the declaration of emergency, by the Commissioner of
- 5 environmental engineering, that the public is in danger due to lack
- 6 of disposal sites, said commissioner may order any municipality
- 7 to accept septage from communities from without the district.
- 8 Provided however, that the addition of said septage does not
- 9 impair the function of said treatment plant, and does not cause
- 10 said septage plants to violate Environmental Protection Agency
- 11 orders.
