AN ACT RELATED TO THE VALIDITY OF FIREARMS LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section (a) of section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following new sentence: — No person, having in effect
4 a license to carry firearms for any purpose issued under section
5 131 or section 131F of chapter 140, shall be deemed in violation
6 of this section.”
