By Ms. Rourke of Lowell, petition of the Mass. Federation of Teachers and Susan F. Rourke for legislation to provide retirement credit for teachers having served in Vista and the Indian Bureau. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING CREDIT FOR VISTA AND INDIAN BUREAU SERVICE IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Section 4, Paragraph H, Chapter 32 of the General Laws
2 be amended to: Any teacher who has served in Vista, or the Indian
3 Bureau shall be allowed to buy that time into the teachers'
4 retirement system and said time shall be considered as creditable
5 service.
