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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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AN ACT TO CONTINUE MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN DISABLED PERSONS WHO REQUIRE HOMEMAKER SERVICES AND WHO ARE EMPLOYED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 15 of chapter 1210 of the acts of 1973 and  
3 chapter 599 of the acts of 1979, is hereby amended by inserting  
4 after the words "function or daily living," the words: — or using  
5 homemaker services.
