AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING TEACHER'S RETIREMENT IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the year one thousand nine hundred and four.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 26B of the General Laws, as amended, shall be amended so that the words "and the Board of Education" shall be inserted after the word "and" in the second sentence.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 26B of the General Laws, as amended, shall be amended so that the words "and the Board of Education" shall be inserted after the word "and" in the first sentence.
