AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF OFFERING AN INDUSTRIAL DESIGN PROGRAM IN THE STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Board of Regents of Higher Education are hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to make a study of the feasibility of
- 3 offering an industrial design program in the state higher
- 4 educational system.
- 5 Said board shall report back to the legislature no later than
- 6 November first, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine with their
- 7 recommendations, including legislation to carry them into effect,
- 8 if necessary, by filing same with the clerk of the house of
- 9 representatives.
