

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE ON ROUTE 2 OVER THE
BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD IN THE TOWN OF AYER AS
THE WILLIAM P. IVERSON BRIDGE. Chap.404

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The bridge on Route 2 over the Boston and Maine railroad tracks in the town of Ayer shall be known and designated as the William P. Iverson Bridge, and a suitable tablet bearing said designation shall be erected and maintained on said bridge by the state department of public works.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE ON ROUTE 2
IN THE TOWN OF AYER AS THE FREDERICK C. CARLTON
CIRCLE. Chap.405

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The traffic circle on Route 2 on the easterly side of the town of Ayer shall be known and designated as the Frederick C. Carlton Circle, and a suitable tablet and marker bearing said designation shall be erected and maintained at said traffic circle by the state department of public works.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF STOUGHTON TO BORROW
MONEY FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES. Chap.406

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purchase of land for school purposes and for the purpose of constructing and originally equipping and furnishing a school building or for an addition to a presently existing school building, the town of Stoughton may borrow from time to time within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Stoughton School Loan, Act of 1950. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and shall, except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
