AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES TO VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 tenth paragraph, the following paragraph:

4 The registrar shall furnish at his office, at no less than cost to
5 veterans, as defined in section seven of chapter four, upon
6 presentation of satisfactory evidence of such status as determined
7 by the registrar, distinctive registration plates designated
8 "veteran" for one pleasure passenger vehicle owned and
9 principally used by said veteran.
