By Mrs. Alexander of Beverly (by request), petition of John A. Petronzio and others for legislation to designate a certain bridge in the cities of Beverly and Salem the Corporal Joseph Vittori Memorial Bridge. Transportation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE CITIES OF BEVERLY AND SALEM AS THE CORPORAL JOSEPH VITTORI MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The bridge to be erected on Route 1A spanning the Danvers  
2 River and connecting the city of Beverly with the city of Salem  
3 shall be designated and known as the Corporal Joseph Vittori  
4 Memorial Bridge in honor of Corporal Joseph Vittori Medal of  
5 Honor, United States Marine Corps. Reserve, of Beverly.  
6 Corporal Vittori, in a most outstanding display of gallantry and  
7 intrepidity above and beyond the call of duty gave his life while  
8 engaged against the enemy forces on the night of 15-16 September,  
9 1951 on hill 749 in Korea. Corporal Vittori was awarded the  
10 Medal of Honor in the name of the Congress, posthumously by  
11 the President of the United States, Harry S. Truman. A suitable  
12 marker bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the  
13 Department of Public Works in compliance with the standards  
14 of said department.
