AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MAKING OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT THE BELLE ISLE MARSH RESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan District Commission is hereby authorized and
2 directed to make the following improvements at the recently
3 acquired Belle Isle Marsh Reservation (formerly the site of the
4 Suffolk Downs Drive-In):

- 5 a. construction of barbecue pits
- 6 b. construction of a child play area
- 7 c. construction of toilet facilities
- 8 d. construction of additional parking spaces
- 9 e. any additional improvements which may be suitable or
10 appropriate.

11 For these purposes the sum of three hundred and fifty thousand
12 dollars is hereby appropriated.
