

building, and originally equipping and furnishing said addition, the town of Westminster may borrow, from time to time, within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Westminster School Addition Loan, Act of 1950. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit, but shall, except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH THE TOWN OF MILLBURY MAY BORROW MONEY FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES. *Chap.467*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 505 of the acts of 1946 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "four" and inserting in place thereof the word: — six, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 1.* For the purposes of acquiring land and constructing thereon a school building, and of originally equipping and furnishing such building, the town of Millbury may borrow from time to time, within a period of six years from the passage of this act, such sums of money as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, three hundred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor which shall bear on their face the words, Millbury School Loan, Act of 1946. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO MARY DERANANIAN AND ZARMAN MOURADIAN, ADMINISTRATRICES OF THE ESTATE OF KEVORK H. MOURADIAN. *Chap.468*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation the town of Arlington may appropriate and pay a sum, not to exceed five thousand dollars, to Mary DerAnanian and Zarman Mouradian, the administratrices of the estate
