### AN ACT PLACING METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION POLICE CAPTAINS UNDER CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 63B the following section: —  
3 Section 63C. Notwithstanding the provision of section forty-  
4 six E and forty-six F of chapter thirty or any other special or  
5 general law to the contrary, the office of captain in the  
6 metropolitan district police force shall be subject to the provision  
7 of chapter thirty-one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
