AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RECORDING OF LAND AT THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 80 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: — Such deed shall not be valid unless
5 recorded within sixty days after the sale under this section; and
6 the title of the town to land conveyed thereby shall be treated as
7 if the procedure set forth in section seventy-nine of chapter sixty
8 of the General Laws had not occurred.

1 SECTION 2. Section 80C of Chapter 60, as so appearing, is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words “or section eighty” in
3 line two.
