AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSE OF SCHOOL BUS OPERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general law to the contrary, each person
- 2 licensed to operate school buses in the commonwealth shall have
- 3 training in basic first aid and C.P.R. and said training shall be
- 4 certified by American Red Cross or American Heart Association
- 5 certified instructors. In addition, said drivers are to be instructed
- 6 in emergency school bus evacuation three times per year.
