The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE STATE POLICE TO TAKE CONTROL OF CERTAIN POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven
3 all employees of the capitol police, metropolitan district
4 commission police, Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority
5 police, and any employee of the registry of motor vehicles who
6 exercises police powers and shall become employees of the state
7 police without impairment of civil service status and seniority and
8 without reduction in compensation, notwithstanding any change
9 in job titles or duties and without loss of accrued rights to holidays,
10 sick leave, vacation and benefits, and shall thereafter perform his
11 or her duties under the direction, control and supervision of said
12 state police.
