AN ACT LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF REAL PROPERTY WHICH THE COMMONWEALTH MAY OWN IN ANY ONE MUNICIPALITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 3A the following section: —

3 Section 3B. In any city or town, the commonwealth or any sub-
4 division thereof shall not hold title, whether acquired by eminent
5 domain, devise, gift, purchase, or otherwise to more than 10% of
6 the total real property located herein without the approval
7 of 2/3 of the city or town legislative body.
