### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENALTY FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90, as appearing in the 1984  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
3 "both", in line 9, the following words: — provided that the  
4 sentence imposed upon such person shall not be reduced to less  
5 than three days, nor suspended, nor shall any such person be  
6 eligible for probation, parole, or furlough or receive any deduction  
7 from his sentence for good conduct until he shall have served three  
8 days of such sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 24 of said chapter 90, as so appear-  
2 ing, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "that",  
3 in line 91, the following words: — the defendant shall be  
4 imprisoned for three days and said three days shall not be reduced  
5 or suspended, nor shall any such defendant be eligible for  
6 probation, parole or furlough or receive any deduction from his  
7 sentence for good conduct until he shall have served said three  
8 days and provided further that.
